

Montana Coffee Company Riverfront Cabin Sweepstakes

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

By entering the Montana Coffee Company Riverfront Cabin Sweepstakes, each entrant agrees to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of Montana Coffee Company, which are final and binding in all matters relating to the Sweepstakes.

1. Sponsor

The sponsor of the Montana Coffee Company Riverfront Cabin Sweepstakes (“Sweepstakes”) is:

Montana Coffee Company is referred to in these Official Rules as the “Sponsor.”

2. Eligibility

The Sweepstakes is open only to legal residents of the fifty United States and the District of Columbia who:

1. Are at least eighteen years old and have reached the age of majority in their state of residence at the time of entry;
2. Possess a valid government-issued photo identification; and
3. Are legally able to accept and use the prize described in these Official Rules.

Employees, officers, directors, owners, agents, and representatives of the Sponsor, the cabin owner or prize provider, and any company involved in the design, administration, advertising, or fulfillment of the Sweepstakes are not eligible.

Immediate family members and household members of those individuals are also ineligible. “Immediate family” includes spouses, parents, legal guardians, children, siblings, grandparents, grandchildren, and each of their respective spouses. “Household members” means people who share the same residence for at least three months during the twelve months preceding the Sweepstakes.

The Sweepstakes is void in Puerto Rico, United States territories and possessions, outside the United States and District of Columbia, and wherever prohibited or restricted by law.

3. Sweepstakes Period

The Sweepstakes begins at 12am Central Time on July 17, 2026.

The Sweepstakes will close on the earlier of:

1. The date and time the Sponsor confirms receipt of the fiftieth valid Qualifying Subscriber Entry; or
2. 12pm (NOON) Central Time on December 31, 2026.

The date on which the Sweepstakes closes is referred to as the “Entry Close Date.”

The Sponsor will post a notice at montanacoffeecompany.online after the Sweepstakes has closed. The publicly displayed subscriber counter is provided for informational purposes and may not update in real time. The Sponsor’s internal order and entry records will determine when the fiftieth Qualifying Subscriber Entry is received.

The Sponsor will continue accepting mail-in entries that were properly postmarked on or before the Entry Close Date and received no later than seven calendar days after the Entry Close Date.

The random drawing will not be conducted until the mail-in receipt period has ended and all timely entries have been reviewed.

4. How to Enter

There are two methods of entry. Each method provides one entry into the same random drawing.

A. Qualifying Subscriber Entry

During the Sweepstakes Period, an eligible individual may receive one automatic entry by completing a valid new subscription order through the Montana Coffee Company website at:

To qualify, the initial order must:

1. Be placed during the Sweepstakes Period;
2. Be associated with an eligible individual;
3. Include at least two eligible Montana Coffee Company coffee bag or K-Cup subscription products;
4. Be successfully submitted and accepted by the Sponsor;
5. Include valid customer contact information; and
6. Have its initial payment successfully authorized and completed.

The natural person identified as the purchaser and account holder will be considered the entrant. Orders submitted through duplicate, fictitious, fraudulent, shared, business, or automated accounts may be disqualified.

A person receives only one Sweepstakes entry regardless of:

- The number of subscription products purchased;
- The number of eligible subscription orders placed;
- The number of subscription frequencies selected;
- The amount spent;
- The length of the subscription; or
- The number of customer accounts used.

The customer is not required to maintain the subscription through the drawing date to retain a valid entry. However, canceled orders that were never paid, orders voided before payment, fraudulent transactions, unauthorized transactions, and orders subject to a payment dispute or chargeback may be deemed ineligible.

The separate free-bag, free-shipping, and recurring subscription discount offers are purchase benefits and do not provide additional Sweepstakes entries.

B. Alternate Method of Entry by Mail

To enter without making a purchase, an eligible individual must hand-print all of the following information in ink on a plain 3-inch-by-5-inch card:

- Full legal name;
- Complete residential mailing address;
- City, state, and ZIP Code;
- Email address;
- Telephone number;
- Date of birth; and
- The exact statement:

“Montana Coffee Company Riverfront Cabin Sweepstakes — No-Purchase Entry.”

The entrant must place the completed card in a standard envelope, hand-address the envelope, affix proper first-class postage, and mail it to:

Each envelope must:

1. Be mailed separately;
2. Contain only one entry card;
3. Be postmarked on or before the Entry Close Date; and
4. Be received no later than seven calendar days after the Entry Close Date.

Typed, computer-generated, photocopied, mechanically reproduced, automated, bulk-mailed, metered-in-bulk, incomplete, illegible, altered, postage-due, late, damaged, misdirected, or improperly submitted entries are void.

Proof of mailing does not constitute proof of receipt. Mail-in entries will not be returned or acknowledged.

Each valid mail-in entry receives one entry into the same drawing as a valid Qualifying Subscriber Entry.

5. Entry Limit

Limit one total Sweepstakes entry per person and per household, regardless of entry method.

An individual may enter through a Qualifying Subscriber Entry or through the alternate mail-in method, but not both.

If the same person submits entries through both methods, only the first valid entry received or recorded by the Sponsor will be included. All subsequent entries associated with that person or household may be voided.

Entrants may not use multiple names, addresses, email addresses, accounts, identities, devices, or other methods to circumvent the entry limit.

A purchase does not increase an entrant's chances of winning.

6. Prize

One grand prize will be awarded.

The grand prize consists of:

- A 2-night riverfront cabin stay for the winner and up to 5 guest(s) at Riverwalk Properties in Fayetteville, TN (riverwalkproperties.hospitable.rentals)

The approximate retail value of the prize is:

\$750

The prize includes only the cabin accommodations expressly described above.

Unless expressly stated otherwise, the prize does not include:

- Transportation or airfare;
- Rental vehicles;
- Fuel;
- Parking;
- Meals or beverages;
- Gratuities;
- Activities or entertainment;
- Travel insurance;
- Personal expenses;
- Security or damage deposits;
- Resort, cleaning, pet, or incidental fees;
- Costs resulting from damage to the property;
- Taxes; or
- Any other expense not specifically identified as part of the prize.

The winner and guest are solely responsible for arranging and paying for transportation to and from the cabin.

The stay must be booked by March 31, 2027 and completed by June 30, 2027.

The reservation is subject to cabin availability, property rules, occupancy restrictions, and the following blackout dates or restrictions:

The winner may be required to provide a valid credit card to the cabin owner or property manager for incidental expenses and damages. The winner and guest must comply with all rules imposed by the cabin owner or property manager.

The winner's guest must be at least 18 years old unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. If the winner is under the minimum age required by the property's booking policies, the Sponsor may require an eligible adult traveling companion to complete the reservation.

No cash equivalent will be provided. The prize is nontransferable and may not be sold, assigned, auctioned, bartered, or transferred to another person without the Sponsor's written approval.

The Sponsor may substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the advertised cabin stay becomes unavailable for reasons outside the Sponsor's reasonable control.

The difference between the stated approximate retail value and the actual value of the prize will not be awarded.

7. Taxes and Expenses

The winner is solely responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes associated with accepting and using the prize.

The winner may be required to provide a Social Security number or taxpayer identification information and complete applicable tax documentation before the prize is awarded.

The Sponsor may issue an IRS Form 1099 or other required tax document based on the value of the prize and applicable law.

8. Random Drawing and Odds

One potential winner will be selected in a random drawing from all eligible entries received through both entry methods.

The drawing will be conducted on or about 10 days after the deadline for receiving timely mail-in entries.

The drawing will be administered by the Sponsor or by an independent person or organization selected by the Sponsor.

The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received.

Subscriber entries and valid mail-in entries will be included in the same drawing pool and will have equal odds of selection.

9. Winner Notification and Verification

The potential winner will be contacted using the email address, telephone number, or mailing address provided with the entry.

The potential winner must respond within seventy-two hours after the Sponsor first attempts notification unless the Sponsor provides a different deadline in writing.

Before receiving the prize, the potential winner may be required to:

- Provide government-issued identification;
- Confirm eligibility;
- Complete and sign an affidavit or declaration of eligibility;
- Complete a liability release;
- Complete a limited publicity release where legally permitted;
- Provide tax information;

- Confirm acceptance of the cabin's rules and restrictions; and
- Complete any reasonable documents required by the cabin owner or property manager.

The potential winner may be disqualified if the person:

- Cannot be contacted;
- Does not respond by the stated deadline;
- Does not satisfy the eligibility requirements;
- Does not provide requested documentation;
- Provides false or incomplete information;
- Declines the prize;
- Is unable or unwilling to use the prize subject to its restrictions;
- Violates these Official Rules; or
- Has a prize notification returned as undeliverable.

If the potential winner is disqualified or forfeits the prize, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner through another random drawing from the remaining eligible entries.

The Sponsor may attempt to contact up to three alternate potential winners. If no eligible potential winner accepts and verifies eligibility after those attempts, the prize may remain unawarded.

The potential winner is not an official winner until eligibility has been verified and the Sponsor has provided written confirmation.

10. Publicity

Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of the prize authorizes the Sponsor to use the winner's name, city and state of residence, voice, photograph, likeness, statements about the Sweepstakes, and basic prize information for reasonable advertising, publicity, and promotional purposes relating to the Sweepstakes.

This permission will last for twelve months following confirmation of the winner and will not require additional compensation, notice, review, or approval.

Nothing in these Official Rules requires the winner to participate in promotional activity where such a requirement is prohibited by applicable law.

11. General Conditions

The Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any person who:

- Tampers with the entry process or operation of the Sweepstakes;
- Attempts to obtain more than the permitted number of entries;
- Uses fraudulent, deceptive, automated, or unfair entry methods;
- Interferes with another person's participation;
- Provides false information;
- Violates these Official Rules;
- Acts in an abusive, threatening, disruptive, or unsportsmanlike manner; or
- Attempts to undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes.

The Sponsor may require reasonable documentation to verify an entrant's identity, residence, age, customer account, mailing address, household, or eligibility.

If fraud, technical failure, unauthorized intervention, natural disaster, government action, public-health emergency, cabin unavailability, or another circumstance outside the Sponsor's reasonable control impairs the integrity or administration of the Sweepstakes, the Sponsor may suspend, modify, extend, or terminate the Sweepstakes.

If the Sweepstakes is terminated before completion, the Sponsor may conduct a random drawing from the eligible entries received before the action or event that caused termination, provided doing so is lawful and reasonably practical.

The Sponsor's failure to enforce any provision of these Official Rules does not waive that provision.

12. Lost or Defective Entries

The Sponsor is not responsible for:

- Lost, late, stolen, incomplete, illegible, damaged, destroyed, delayed, postage-due, or misdirected mail;
- Incorrect or inaccurate entry information;
- Internet, website, server, hosting, payment, email, telephone, or technical failures;
- Delayed order processing;
- Failed payment authorizations;
- Incorrect subscriber-counter displays;
- Unauthorized human intervention;
- Errors in advertising or promotional materials;
- Printing or typographical errors; or
- Events beyond the Sponsor's reasonable control.

If an error affects the number or validity of entries, the Sponsor may correct the error in a reasonable manner consistent with these Official Rules.

13. Release and Limitation of Liability

By entering, each entrant agrees, to the fullest extent permitted by law, to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, cabin owner, prize provider, advertising partners, service providers, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents, and representatives from claims, injuries, losses, liabilities, costs, and damages arising from or relating to:

- Participation in the Sweepstakes;
- Acceptance, possession, use, misuse, or inability to use the prize;
- Travel to or from the cabin;
- Activities occurring at or near the cabin;
- Personal injury;
- Property damage;
- Illness;
- Death;
- Taxes;
- Publicity rights;
- Privacy rights; or
- Any violation of these Official Rules by the entrant.

Nothing in these Official Rules excludes liability that cannot legally be excluded.

The winner and guest assume the ordinary risks associated with travel, lodging, outdoor environments, weather, water, terrain, wildlife, and activities undertaken during the cabin stay.

14. Disputes and Governing Law

The Sweepstakes and these Official Rules are governed by the laws of the State of Tennessee, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.

To the extent permitted by law, any dispute arising from or relating to the Sweepstakes must be brought individually and not as part of a class, collective, or representative action.

Any legal proceeding must be filed in a state or federal court with jurisdiction over Lincoln County, Tennessee, unless applicable law requires a different location.

To the extent permitted by law, entrants waive claims for punitive, incidental, consequential, special, or indirect damages and waive any right to have damages multiplied or increased.

An entrant's recovery will be limited to documented out-of-pocket expenses directly associated with entering the Sweepstakes, excluding attorneys' fees, except where otherwise required by law.

15. Privacy

Information collected through the Sweepstakes will be used to:

- Administer the Sweepstakes;
- Verify eligibility;
- Contact potential winners;
- Fulfill the prize;
- Prevent fraud or duplicate entries;
- Satisfy legal and tax obligations; and
- Maintain records relating to the promotion.

Information associated with subscription orders will also be handled according to the Sponsor's Privacy Policy, available at:

montanacoffeecompany.online/policies

Submitting a mail-in entry does not automatically enroll the entrant in promotional email or text-message marketing.

The Sponsor may offer entrants a separate opportunity to consent to marketing communications, but such consent is not required to enter or win and will not affect the entrant's odds.

16. Separate Subscription Offer Terms

The subscription launch offer—including the free coffee bag, free first-order shipping, and recurring subscription savings—is separate from the cabin Sweepstakes prize.

The subscription offer is available only to qualifying customers and may be subject to separate eligibility requirements, product restrictions, customer limits, expiration dates, and exclusions.

Unless otherwise stated in the applicable offer terms:

- The customer must add two eligible subscription products and one eligible coffee bag as a one-time purchase to the same initial order;
- The discount applies only to the eligible one-time-purchase bag;
- Free shipping applies only to the initial qualifying subscription order;
- Recurring savings depend on the eligible product and subscription option selected;
- The introductory offer is limited to new subscribers;
- The offer is limited to one use per customer and household;
- The offer may not be combined with certain other promotions or coupons; and
- Subscription products renew according to the billing and delivery frequency selected at checkout until canceled in accordance with the applicable subscription terms.

Receiving subscription benefits does not provide more than one Sweepstakes entry.

A no-purchase entrant receives an equal opportunity to win the cabin prize but does not receive the separate commercial benefits associated with purchasing a subscription.

17. Social-Media Disclaimer

The Sweepstakes may be advertised on Facebook, Instagram, X, TikTok, YouTube, or other social-media platforms.

The Sweepstakes is not sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Meta, Facebook, Instagram, X, TikTok, YouTube, or any other social-media platform.

By entering, entrants release those platforms from claims arising from or relating to the Sweepstakes.

Questions, comments, and complaints regarding the Sweepstakes should be directed to the Sponsor and not to a social-media platform.

18. Winner Announcement

After the winner has been verified, the Sponsor may publish the winner's first name, last initial, city, and state on any and all social media outlets utilized by the Sponsor.

The winner information may remain available for at least ninety days.

A person may also request the winner's name by mailing a self-addressed, stamped envelope to:

Requests must be received within ninety days after the drawing date.
